SHOW

Red Earth Uncovered is a 13 episode documentary series where a host investigates Aboriginal linkages and relevance to both archaeological discoveries and ancient myths and legends, such as Ogopogo in Okanagan Lake and Sasquatch in Alberta and BC interior.

The Red Earth Uncovered series take viewers on an adventure to places where world-renowned mysteries remain elusive. The possibilities and truths about what could be and how Aboriginal peoples may have played a role in these well-known historical events and stories are uncovered.

Tom Jackson and Shayla Stonechild lead the adventure in Red Earth Uncovered. Tom is a pathfinder chronicler who is excited about the stories and untold truths of the legends. Shayla Stonechild is a young, eager explorer who wants to delve into the mysteries and discover the unknown.

Tom gives Shayla exciting off-site assignments to various locations where the myths abound. Shayla interviews locals and Aboriginal Peoples to get perspective and understanding about each story; and then explores to get first-hand experience in hopes of uncovering truths.



TOM JACKSON

Dr. Tom Jackson is the *Pathfinder Chronicler* with the goal of delving into notorious and longstanding legends from an Aboriginal perspective. His motivation is personal as he grew up hearing stories and at time, experienced encounters with the unknown. He wants to prove the existence and/or non-existence of each legend in hopes of uncovering truths and myths. Dr. Jackson hires a young apprentice – the Explorer – to help him make these discoveries.



SHAYLA STONECHILD

Shayla Stonechild is the young, naïve and eager *Explorer*. Shayla shares the same interest and passion as her mentor and willingly goes out to explore the unknown. She hopes to find hard evidence to bring back to the Chronicler Pathfinder as well as satisfy her own curiosity about each legend. Just as Dr. Tom Jackson, Shayla has also grown up hearing stories about the unknown within her Aboriginal community. She hopes to uncover truths to cast out any and all doubt or disbelief.

EPISODES

Episode 201: Howling in the Holler


Tom tells Shayla to go to Kentucky to check out mysterious livestock maulings that were allegedly done by a creature known as the Waddy Werewolf.

Episode 202: Fear of Fairies

Tom asks Shayla if she's heard about a thing called fey realm. He mentions vague details of a guy who went missing on Bell Island and wants Shayla to go there to find out what happened.

Episode 203: The Trouble with Trimble

Tom Jackson sends Shayla to Cryptid Con where believers of all things unknown gather to prove and discuss cryptids such as Sasquatch, dogman, and UFOs.

Episode 204: Crescent Presence

Tom sends Shayla to Robert's Arm to check out a lake monster known as Cressie. He asks her to find out what this creature is and if it actually exists.

Episode 205: Lakeshore Dogman

Tom sends Shayla to Michigan to check out the Michigan Dogman. He reveals that most sightings occur near water. In fact, a lot of sightings have been around Lake Michigan.

Episode 206: Get Kraken!

Tom sends Shayla to find out about the giant squid that have been found in the cold, Atlantic waters.

Episode 207: Whoop, There it is!

Tom sends Shayla to Kentucky to find out about Bigfoot and see if the creature is the same entity that people are seeing in Canada.

Episode 208: Fairies in the Rock

Tom sends Shayla to the East Coast to see if their fairies are evil like the Bell Island fairies or if they are the same entity as Little People.

Episode 209: A Muddy Save

Tom tells Shayla to go further down the Pacific Northwest and see if the people are seeing the same Sasquatch as she has found in other places. He tells her to go visit the Yakama Nation.

Episode 210: Nanabijou - The Sleeping Giant

Tom tells Shayla that the Ojibwa legends in Thunder Bay are worth checking out. In particular, he wants her to go find out about and see The Sleeping Giant.

EPISODES

Episode 211: Princess Green Mantle

While in Thunder Bay, Shayla calls Tom and asks if she can stay to check out a second legend in nearby, Kakabeka Falls.

Episode 212: Kingsoo

Tom sends Shayla to Cold Lake, Alberta to learn about the legend of the great fish that lives in the Lake known as Kinosoo.

Episode 213: Bob Gimlin, the Legend Behind the Legend

Tom tells Shayla to go meet the Legend behind Bigfoot and talk to Bob Gimlin. Bob was one of the eyewitnesses of “Patty” in the Patterson-Gimlin film, which is the first video footage of Bigfoot.
